LIT 104 must be taken at Menlo if there is no equivalent course to HUM 001 AND HUM 002. Specific courses may be required as a prerequisite for Major and/or Concentration upper division courses. • Vocational Associates Degrees will not be accepted. • Students need to earn a grade of "C-" or better for the course to be considered for transfer credit. • American River College courses may be only taken once for transfer credit to Menlo College. • American River College courses, which do not fulfill specific Menlo College requirements, will be accepted for transfer as General Electives. • American River College courses, in non-vocational programs, will be considered for transfer on a course-by-course basis. • Menlo College does not accept vocational or correspondence courses for transfer. • Transfer students will receive credit for the total number of units accepted for transfer. However, grades received in transfer courses will not be counted in a student's Menlo GPA. • Up to 70 semester units of lower division course work may be transferred to Menlo. A maximum of 4 semester units of P.E. will be counted towards graduation. • This agreement is subject to change and students may appeal transfer evaluation to Menlo Faculty Appeals Committee.
