LIT 104 must be taken at Menlo if there is no equivalent course to HUM 001 AND HUM 002. Specific courses may be required as a prerequisite for Major and/or Concentration upper division courses. • Vocational Associates Degrees will not be accepted. • Students need to earn a grade of "C-" or better for the course to be considered for transfer credit. • City College of San Francisco courses may be only taken once for transfer credit to Menlo College. • City College of San Francisco courses not specifically noted but which transfer to the University of California will be accepted as general units for transfer credit at Menlo College. City College of San Francisco which transfer to the California State University system will be considered for transfer on a course-by-course basis. • Menlo College does not accept vocational or correspondence courses for transfer. • Transfer students will receive credit for the total number of units accepted for transfer. However, grades received in transfer courses will not be counted in a student's Menlo GPA. • Up to 70 semester units of lower division course work may be transferred to Menlo. A maximum of 4 semester units of P.E. will be counted towards graduation. • This agreement is subject to change and students may appeal transfer evaluation to Menlo Faculty Appeals Committee.
