The following exceptions apply:  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Menlo College requires all graduates to complete the equivalent of MIS 305, MGT 001, MGT 002, ECO 055, a 4 unit lab science course, and, depending on major, MTH 002 or MTH 10.</li> <li>LIT 104 must be taken at Menlo if student has not taken a course equivalent to HUM 001 AND HUM 002</li> <li>Specific courses may be required as a prerequisite for Major and/or Concentration upper division courses.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Students need to earn a grade of “C-” or better for the course to be considered for transfer credit.</li> <li>• Courses which do not meet general education requirements may be transferred as general elective units and will be evaluated on a course by course basis.</li> <li>• Menlo College does not accept college preparatory or ESL courses for credit.</li> <li>• Up to 70 semester units of lower division course work may be transferred to Menlo. A maximum of six quarter units of physical education will be counted towards graduation.</li> </ul>
